Please accept this letter as our weekly update regarding the status of COVID-19 in our facility. As a reminder, the Skilled Nursing Facility unit consists of rooms 405 through 410 and Skilled Nursing Facility Employees are all employees that work on the 400 hall. We are happy to report that we currently have no confirmed cases of COVID-19 in our Skilled Nursing facility.

As we have no Covid-19 cases in our Skilled Nursing Facility we are able to have outside visitation at this time. We do ask that all visitors maintain social distancing, wear a mask and use hand sanitizer. Visitation hours will be daily from 3:00 pm to 7:00 pm. Due to the high positivity rate in Clark County, we are limiting visitors to one visitor per resident at a time in order to maintain social distancing. All visitors must check in with receptionist to be screened for Covid-19 symptoms prior to visiting.
