Dear Residents and Families/Representatives,

Please accept this letter as our weekly update regarding the status of COVID-19 in our facility. We are happy to report that, as of today, we have no confirmed cases of COVID-19 in our facility. The SNF facility consists of the rooms 405, 406, 407, 408, 409 and 410 and includes the staff members that work on 400 hall.

As we have no current cases of Covid-19 among the SNF facility residents and staff, we are able to have outside patio visitation daily from 3pm to 7pm. Masks are required and all visitors must be screened at the front desk prior to visitation. Please remember to maintain social distance of six feet.

We continue to test all SNF facility staff twice weekly. All staff whether or not vaccinated must wear a mask and proper PPE in the facility. In addition, we continue to screen all staff prior to work for any signs or symptoms of Covid-19.

Please continue to check our website for weekly updates as well as notification of new cases. As always, we will notify you if we receive confirmation of a new positive case in our facility and we will reach out to you individually if your loved one is displaying symptoms of COVID-19 or tests positive for COVID-19.

Dear Residents and Families/Representatives,

Please accept this letter as our weekly update regarding the status of COVID-19 in our facility. As a reminder, the Skilled Nursing Facility unit consists of rooms 405 through 410 and Skilled Nursing Facility Employees are all employees that work on the 400 hall. We are happy to report that we currently have no confirmed cases of COVID-19 in our Skilled Nursing facility.

As we have no Covid-19 cases in our Skilled Nursing Facility we are able to have outside visitation at this time. We do ask that all visitors maintain social distancing, wear a mask and use hand sanitizer. Visitation hours will be daily from 3:00 pm to 7:00 pm. Due to the high positivity rate in Clark County, we are limiting visitors to one visitor per resident at a time in order to maintain social distancing. All visitors must check in with receptionist to be screened for Covid-19 symptoms prior to visiting. I have had requests for pet visitation. This is allowed with the following guidelines: pets must be on a leash and controlled at all times, pets must have proof of vaccination for rabies, and visitation is confined to the outside courtyard.

Dear Residents and Families/Representatives,

Please accept this letter as our weekly update regarding the status of COVID-19 in our facility. The Harmon Hospital Skilled Nursing Facility consists of rooms 405 through 410. We are happy to report that, as of today, we have no confirmed cases of COVID-19 in our facility.

As we have zero new cases of Covid-19 among the staff or residents of the Skilled Nursing Facility we are able to continue to have visitors at this time. Please continue to have your visitors check in at the front desk to be screened. All visitors must wear a mask and maintain six feet social distance at all times. Visitation remains in the courtyard, unless otherwise pre-arranged due to medical issues. Visitors may bring clothing, pictures or activity items when visiting.
