VISITATION STATUS

Due to continued zero cases of Covid-19 among the staff and residents, visitation will continue as set up: Outside visitation, six feet social distance, wearing masks at all times. If food is brought in, please do not eat during visitation, as masks must remain on at all times. All visitors must check in at the reception desk. Pet visits are allowed with proof of current pet vaccinations, pet must remain on a leash. If visitation requires special considerations, please contact the administrator to make arrangements.

As always, we will notify you if we receive confirmation of a new positive case in our facility and we will reach out to you individually if your loved one is displaying symptoms of COVID-19 or tests positive for COVID-19.

Dear Residents and Families/Representatives,

Please accept this letter as our weekly update regarding the status of COVID-19 in our facility. We are happy to report that, as of today, we have no confirmed cases of COVID-19 in our facility. The Nursing Facility is rooms 405 through 410, and includes the staff working on the 400 hall. We continue testing Nursing Facility staff weekly although this may increase or decrease as indicated by the county positivity rate.

As vaccinations have increased and Clark County positivity rates decreased, Harmon Hospital-SNF is now allowing indoor visitation. The process for visitation remains the same; check in at reception, face mask at all times during the visit and social distancing during visit. Indoor visitation can be in resident rooms if the resident is in a single room. If the resident is not in a single room indoor visitation is available in the dining room, activity room, conference room or on the SNF unit therapy room. Outdoor visitation continues to be an option as well. Please refrain from eating, drinking or smoking during visitation times as that requires removing facemasks. The entire visitation policy is available at the nursing station, reception desk and each resident is given a copy upon admission.

Please continue to check our website for weekly updates as well as notification of new cases. As always, we will notify you if we receive confirmation of a new positive case in our facility and we will reach out to you individually if your loved one is displaying symptoms of COVID-19 or tests positive for COVID-19.

Dear Residents and Families/Representatives,

Please accept this letter as our weekly update regarding the status of COVID-19 in our facility. The Harmon Hospital Skilled Nursing Facility consists of rooms 405 through 410. We are happy to report that, as of today, we have no confirmed cases of COVID-19 in our facility.

As we have zero new cases of Covid-19 among the staff or residents of the Skilled Nursing Facility we are able to continue to have visitors at this time. Please continue to have your visitors check in at the front desk to be screened. All visitors must wear a mask and maintain six feet social distance at all times. Visitation remains in the courtyard, unless otherwise pre-arranged due to medical issues. Visitors may bring clothing, pictures or activity items when visiting. At this time eating during visitation is not allowed as this would require masks to be removed.

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
