## WEEKLY UPDATE

Dear Residents and Families/Representatives,

Please accept this letter as our weekly update regarding the status of COVID-19 in our facility. We are happy to report that, as of today, we have no confirmed cases of COVID-19 in our facility. The Harmon Hospital Nursing Facility consists of rooms 405 through 410.

The Clark County Covid-19 positivity rate has increased to above 5% at this time requiring staff to resume weekly testing. At this time residents will not be required to test for Covid-19 as there are no positive cases in the facility. Harmon Hospital & SNF is in the process of finalizing arrangements to offer the Covid-19 vaccine at the facility to staff and residents. Vaccination can also be provided by local Walgreens or CVS pharmacies, Harmon will provide transportation for resident vaccinations.

Please remember to practice infection prevention during visitation. All visitors are required to screen at the front desk upon entry. Masks are required at all times as well as maintaining six feet social distancing. Food brought in by visitors must not be eaten during visitation as both resident and visitors must wear masks during each visit. Currently we are requesting the visitation be limited to 3PM to 7PM seven days a week to ensure that necessary screening, personal protective equipment and staff are available to assist during visits. If a different time is necessary for visitation please contact us and we will plan for other visitation times.

Please continue to check our website for weekly updates as well as notification of new cases. As always, we will notify you if we receive confirmation of a new positive case in our facility and we will reach out to you individually if your loved one is displaying symptoms of COVID-19 or tests positive for COVID-19.
