Dear Residents and Families/Representatives,

Please accept this letter as our weekly update regarding the status of COVID-19 in our facility. We are happy to report that we currently have no confirmed cases of COVID-19 in our facility. The licensed nursing facility includes rooms 405 through 410, and includes all staff who are assigned to work in the 400-hall unit of the facility.

The Clark County Covid-19 positivity rate continues to decline as the number of Covid-19 vaccinated people has increased. As a result of the lower positivity rate, Harmon Hospital-SNF is able to offer both indoor and outdoor visitation. Although the face mask mandate has been lifted in most areas, it continues to remain a requirement in medical facilities, and visitors must wear a facemask at all times in the facility. Please remember to practice social distancing and use of hand sanitizer during visitation. The current visitation hours are daily from 3:00 pm to 7:00 pm. Visitation outside of the established times can be arranged through social services, nursing or the Administrator. Children under the age of nine or unable to safely wear a facemask are not allowed to visit at this time. Dogs are allowed to accompany visitors, but must remain on a leash and have proof of current rabies vaccination. If you or your visitor has any illness that is considered contagious and must practice isolation procedures visitation is allowed only in cases of compassionate care and/or with arrangements made by the physician, social services and nursing.

Please continue to check our website www.harmonmedicalrehab.com for weekly updates as well as notification of new cases. As always, we will notify you if we receive confirmation of a new positive case in our facility and we will reach out to you individually if your loved one is displaying symptoms of COVID-19 or tests positive for COVID-19.
